It breaks our hearts to see those who come in so sick or malnourished that we are unsure which ones will live to see the next week. These are the circumstances in which we live. We see parents who desperately want their children to thrive but do not have the economic resources to bring it to pass. We see others who do not even know how to properly bathe their children or care for their basic needs. These are the people we care for each week.



Many of the mothers who come to us have had twins. As some of the mothers are older, have already had many children, or do not even have proper nutrition to support their own bodies, it is impossible for them to produce enough milk to nurse both of the twins. It is exciting to see the babies fill out as they receive their milk supplements. The parents are so grateful!

This quarter we would like to ask for special prayer for a

little boy named Juan Panjoj, whom we fondly call Juanito. Juanito was making significant progress in the milk program as well as the physical therapy program here. But during the last few months, he has begun to have devastating seizures which have reversed his progress significantly. Before he could run; now he can barely stand. Before he was mischievous and all smiles; now he is serious and lethargic. His mother does not know how to properly care for him. Please pray that she will give him his medicine consistently and that God will do a miracle in this little boy's life.
